
FACILITY:	Founded in 1968, ExxonMobil's Plastics Plant in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, occupies a 118-acre site.
WORKFORCE:	The plant is an equal opportunity employer staffed by approximately 217 full-time and 98 contract personnel.
PAYROLL:	The plant has an annual payroll of \$32.1M.
LOCAL TAXES:	A total of \$.08M is paid annually in state and local taxes.
PURCHASES:	The plant purchases approximately \$128 million in goods and services annually from local merchants.
PRODUCTION:	From an initial capacity of 180 million pounds, the plant capacity has grown to over 900 million pounds of low density polyethylene and 200 million pounds of ethylene elastomer products.
PRODUCTS:	Using ethylene, vinyl acetate and various modifiers as feedstock, Baton Rouge Plastics Plant (BRPP) produces low-density polyethylene. Its end products include plastic films, molding, adhesives, compounding and oil additives. In addition, using ethylene, propylene, ENB and octene as feedstock, the plant's Metallocene Ethylene Elastomers (mEE) manufacturing facility produces Vistalon®, EP(D)M, Exact®, plastomers and Vistamaxx™ Specialty Elastomers. Their end products include automotive hoses, belts, seals and bumpers, roofing sheet, oil viscosity modifiers and various film and non-woven products.
PRODUCT SHIPMENT:	70 percent of all materials produced at the plant are shipped via covered railroads. The remaining 30 percent is carried in trucks.
SAFETY RECORD:	The Plastics Plant's safety program continues to shine as an OSHA STAR site. As of YE 2007, the employees have a TRIR of 0.39.
