1. Continue driving unless directed otherwise by emergency personnel or traffic controls.
2. Close windows, vents; turn off air conditioner/heater.
3. Turn your radio to 1620AM CitiSOUNDS and listen for further instructions.
4. If your vehicle stalls, DO NOT start the engine. Shelter In Place.

1. Shelter In Place. DO NOT start the engine!
2. Close windows, vents; turn off air conditioner/heater.
3. Turn your radio to 1620AM CitiSOUNDS and listen for further instructions.

### SHELTER IN PLACE



1. Go indoors immediately.



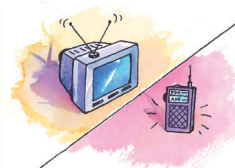
2. Close doors and windows.



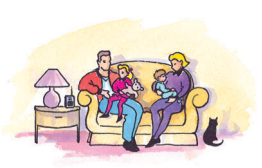
3. Turn off heaters and air conditioners. Close fireplace dampers.



4. Additional precautions to consider: cover nose and mouth with wet cloth and seal windows.



5. Watch Torrance CitiCABLE 3 or local television stations. Listen to KNX 1070AM, KFVB 980AM or Torrance CitiSOUNDS 1620AM.



6. Wait for additional instructions. Following an "all clear" message, air out your home.
